

Creation

Genesis 1-2

Kindergarten and Grade 1

	Large Group (Where we all meet together and introduce the lesson)
	Materials needed - sticky notes, markers
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Greet all the kids as they come in. Ask them how they are doing, and chat with them about their week. Pray together, ask anyone if they have any prayer requests.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Give each of the kids a sticky note. Ask them to draw a picture of their favourite part of creation. Put all of the creation sticky notes on the wall.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Let's watch this video together. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uaTICoviQKA&list=PL5aPdmniG3y_n7hXEKTV4qQnleCe-p6Ws&index=43
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Divide the wall into 7 days. Watch the video again, this time stopping at each day to organize the sticky note pictures. For example stop the video after the first day and ask they kids to find any pictures that go with the first day. Put them in the day 1 section. Continue doing this for all the days. If there aren't any pictures for one of the days, just ask one or two kids to quickly draw a picture.

Break up into small groups

	Review The Story (a chance to review the bible passage with the small group)
	Materials needed - Jesus Storybook Bible, camera, printer, creation memory pack
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- As kids are coming into your small group, take a picture of each child and send it to the printer. (these pictures will be used for the life application exercise)
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Greet everyone in your small group, make sure everyone knows each others names. Say a prayer together either by repeating after one of the teachers or just letting them pray.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read "The Beginning: a perfect home" on page 18 in "The Jesus Storybok Bible".
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Give the kids each a copy of the creation memory pack (found at https://christianpreschoolprintables.com/wp-content/uploads/PPP/Creation/CreationMemoryPack.pdf) all cut out and ready to go.- Give each kid a space on the floor where their cards won't get mixed up with another kids cards. Ask them to match up the pictures with the numbers - help out the kids who are struggling.- Once all the kids have their cards in order, call out a number and ask the kids to call out or act out something that was created on that day.

Life Application (an opportunity for kids to apply the lesson to their own lives)

Materials needed -pictures of kids, creation bookmark, pencil crayons, string, glue, copy of psalm 23

- Have a conversation with the kids. How do they feel about God making them? How do they feel about God making them and saying they are good?
- Get the kids to say "God says I am good". Get them to say it while doing different things (jumping up and down, standing on one foot, standing on the other foot, running to one wall, running to another wall, doing jumping jacks, etc.
- Get the kids pictures that were taken at the beginning of class, let them cut them out and put glue them to their book marks, glue the 23 psalm on the back of the book mark, let them colour in the words and the back ground. Put the book marks through the laminator, then let the kids add a tassel at the top using string.

Memory Verse (a way to introduce and reinforce this months memory verse)

Materials needed - Psalm 23 sheet,

- Read through the 23rd psalm with the kids.
- Let them know that they are going to get a month to memorize it and if they do they will get an ice cream party with all the other kids who memorized it as well.
- Read through the beginning of the 23rd psalm in different voices, high, low, underwater, crazy etc.
