

Isaac Gets Married

Genesis 24

Kindergarten and Grade 1

Large Group (Where we all meet together and introduce the lesson)

Materials needed - 3 small cups, 3 bowls, 1 large bucket, water

- Greet all the kids as they come in. Ask them how they are doing, and chat with them about their week. Pray together, ask anyone if they have any prayer requests.

- go outside to have a relay race. Divide the group into 3 teams and have them at one end of an open area. Place a watering bowl at the opposite side of each team. When you say go, the first person in each team needs to take a cup, go to the big bucket, fill the cup with water and race down to their watering bowl, drop the water off and run back. They will then hand their cup off to the next person who will do the same thing. The race continues until one team has their watering bowl overflowing.

Ask these Questions - you can divide the group into teams and see if there is a team that can answer the most questions...

- What did Abraham ask his servant to do?
- What was the name of the girl who met the servant at the well?
- How did the servant know that Rebekah was supposed to be Isaac's wife?
- What did Rebekah want to go and meet Isaac?
- How do you think Rebekah felt when she left home?

Break up into small groups

Review The Story (a chance to review the bible passage with the small group)

Materials needed -outline pictures of a camel, well, the servant and Rebekah, blank pieces of paper, something to colour with, glue, a boy and a girl doll or stuffed animal, Spark Bible

- Greet everyone in your small group, make sure everyone knows each others names. Say a prayer together either by repeating after one of the teachers or just letting them pray.

- Read Rebekah and Isaac on page 38 in the Spark Bible

- Give the kids a blank piece of paper each and all four of the cutouts. Ask them to recreate the scene at the well. (Have an example for the kids already done so they can copy it).

- set up a fake wedding of Rebekah and Isaac. Use stuffed animals or dolls to be Rebekah and Isaac, the kids can make some rings and set up the wedding however they would like. Have one of the leaders perform the wedding.

Life Application (an opportunity for kids to apply the lesson to their own lives)

Materials needed -

- Think of a story of where God provided for you and tell it to the kids. It should be something to which they can relate.

- Ask the kids if they have any stories where God has provided for them? Has God helped them in any way? Have they prayed about something and then they have seen God provide?

- Take some time and pray together. Ask them if they have any prayer requests.

Memory Verse (a way to introduce and reinforce this months memory verse)

Materials needed - Luke 2 sheet

- We are going to get ready for Christmas. I would like everyone to memorize the Christmas story from the bible.

- Please use a large copy of Luke 2:8 - 20 to recite it with the kids. Then give the kids a copy to take home.
