

Jesus Gets Baptized

Matthew 3:11-17

Kindergarten and Grade 1

Large Group (Where we all meet together and introduce the lesson)

Materials needed - TV or computer, a few cameras and copies of Matthew 3:11-17

- Greet all the kids as they come in. Ask them how they are doing, and chat with them about their week. Pray together, ask anyone if they have any prayer requests.
- Our memory verse for the month is Matthew 5:8. Play this video while singing along, or have a little dance party. (<http://www.worshiphousekids.com/kids-worship-song-tracks/55959/they-will-see-god-matthew-58>)
- Divide the kids up into smaller groups with a mixed age range, and one of the older kids in the group to be the leader and give them a copy of Matthew 3:11 - 17. Ask the kids to read through the story together.
- Once they have finished, ask them to run around the church as a group and take a picture of all the things in the story that are highlighted in blue (they might have to get a bit creative). Let all the kids come back. Read through the story as a group, when you get to a blue highlighted word let each of the groups show their picture.
- Ask them if they have a favourite part of the story.

Break up into small groups

Review The Story (a chance to review the bible passage with the small group)

Materials needed - cut out people (laminated), dry erase markers, water, paper towel, flash light

- Greet everyone in your small group, make sure everyone knows each others names. Say a prayer together either by repeating after one of the teachers or just letting them pray.
- Give everyone a laminated cut out person and a few dry erase markers. Ask the kids to colour in the cut out person so that it becomes Jesus. Using your own words tell the story of Jesus getting baptized. When you get to the part about the skys opening and a voice coming down from heave, shine your flashlight on each of the kids cut out person and have they say, "this is my Son, I love him".
- Let the kids clean off their cut out person.
- Ask the kids to tell the story in their own words. Ask them all to sit down and ask one of the kids to start the story, then ask the next kid to tell the next part and so on.

Life Application (an opportunity for kids to apply the lesson to their own lives)

Materials needed - "Ways to show you love Jesus" sheet

- Have a discussion with the kids. Ask them questions like: Have you ever seen someone get baptized? Have you been baptized? Why do people get baptized? (to keep things simple lets say that people get baptized to show the world that they love Jesus.
- Ask the kids if they can think of any other ways we can show people that we love Jesus?
- Have all the "ways to show you love Jesus" pieces of paper cut out. Ask one of the kids to pick a piece of paper (read it to them if they can't read). Get them to act it out, while the other kids guess. Keep doing this with all the pieces of paper.
- Give each of the kids a name tag or label. Ask them to write, I love Jesus on it and put it on their shirt. Tell them that another way to tell people that you love Jesus is to write it on your shirt.

Memory Verse (a way to introduce and reinforce this months memory verse)

Materials needed - memory verse sheets and tape

- Hide the memory verse words around the room. Ask the kids to go on a treasure hunt and find all the words. Once all the words are found, put them in order and have the kids read the words with you. Say the whole memory verse while point at each of the words. Take one of the pieces of paper away and say the memory verse again. Take another piece away and say it again. Keep going like this until all the pieces of paper are gone and you are saying the verse by memory.
